GENERAL INFORMATION

- Camp runs from July 16-27, Mon-Fri from 9am-4pm (except for the final day)
- Camp will take place at **two locations**: Theatre Raleigh Studios (Week 1) and the Kennedy Theatre (Week 2). See below for more information.
- On the final day, there will be two public performances: July 27th at 3pm & 6pm
- Each student will receive **2 complimentary tickets** to be used at either performance. To use these tickets, we recommend making a reservation in advance by emailing us at <boxoffice@theatreraleigh.com>. Walk-ups will be allowed at each performance while space permits.
- Additional tickets are available to purchase at www.TheatreRaleigh.com/summer-camp. (Tickets are \$10 for adults and \$5 for children 12 & under.)
- Drop-off is no earlier than 8:45 am and pick-up is no later than 4:15 pm. On the last day of camp, all students must be picked up by 7:15 p.m. after the performance.

What to bring:

- A plastic or metal water bottle that can be refilled throughout the day. No glass please!
- A wholesome lunch and at least 2 substantial snacks. (Nothing that needs refrigeration or re-heating.)
- A pencil to take notes.

What to wear:

- Dress in clothes you can move around in! We advise against jeans, as they are not great for dancing. Bring a sweater or sweatshirt.
- Shoes should be fully enclosed, either dance shoes or sneakers secured with laces or velcro. NO flip-flops, NO sandals, NO crocs or shoes that have slippery soles or come off easily.
- *On the final day*, wear plain dark pants with no lettering. (Camp T-shirt will be provided for the performances.)

CAMP LOCATION INFORMATION

Week 1: Theatre Raleigh Studios (3027 Barrow Drive Raleigh, NC 27616)

• NOTE: For the first week, we have rented additional space directly across the street at Millennium Revival Center. Students will be accompanied by a staff member anytime they are required to move between the two locations (a two-minute walk). Drop-off and pickup will always be in the same location - specific information will be provided upon registration.

Week 2: Kennedy Theatre (2 E. South Street Raleigh, NC 27601)

- For the second week, students will be working inside the Kennedy Theatre, which is located around the back of the Duke Energy Center for the Performing Arts.
- Students should be dropped off/picked up via the Kennedy Theatre parking lot. Cars can pull directly up to the curb and drop off/pick up students from the covered portico. Additional information will be provided upon registration.
